### 1 Edzell Golf Club West Water Course

The club is situated midway between Dundee and Aberdeen. Take the B966 (signposted Edzell) just north of Brechin and continue to the village. Turn left past the hotel and continue on Dunlappie Road for 0.5 miles. West Water Course and Driving Range is on the left.

### 2 Forbes of Kingennie Kingennie Golf Course

A challenge for all levels of golfers, Kingennie Golf Course, created in summer 2007, meanders around the Forbes of Kingennie Country Estate. From the A90 Dundee to Arbroath carriageway turn off at Dobbies Garden Centre and follow the signs for Forbes of Kingennie.

Kingennie Golf Course

This new 9 hole course with stunning views of the Kingennie Estate and down to Carnoustie is a true test for all golfers. Although not particularly long this is a risk and reward course – if you are prepared to give it a go you will score well.

To complement the golf course a Driving Range with Target Golf and an 18-hole putting green also built to USGA standards is available.

The amenities at Kingennie are of a very high standard and include the Waterside restaurant, Cairn O' Mount bar, fishing, putting, woodland walks and maze, so if you visit the course as part of a golfing break you certainly won't be disappointed.

The course is located in the beautiful village of Edzell, midway between the cities of Dundee and Aberdeen.

Today the course is situated in some 128 acres and has been complemented with the addition of the 9 hole West Water course in 2001.
